- 1. In consideration of the publication of the Conference Proceeding, I hereby assign to NIE with full title guarantee all rights of copyright and related rights in the above specified Conference Proceeding which is intended for publication in all forms and all media (whether known at this time or developed at any time in the future) throughout the world, in all languages, for the full term of copyright, to take effect if and when the Conference Proceeding is accepted for publication in *Redesigning Pedagogy International Conference (RPIC)*.
- 2. I hereby recognize that by entering into this Agreement, NIE shall be assigned copyright to publish the final, definitive and citable Conference Proceeding, and that as a consequence of this Agreement, their rights include but are not limited to:
